Secure and easy to manage


The adapter uses enterprise-grade security. So you can roll out wireless phones while your network stays secure.

Set up couldn't be simpler

1. Use the supplied ethernet cable to plug the MiVoice WLAN Adapter into the network port of your 6900, 6800 or 5300 series phone, or your MiVoice Conference or Video phone.
2. Set up the adapter to connect to your home office or wireless business network. And away you go.

Other MiVoice IP phone models, including conference and video ones, can be connected using wi-fi protected setup (WPS) or a standard web browser.
